## 2020 APPLICATION GUIDELINES

### 1. Criteria for eligibility

- A. Applicants must be \*immediate family member of a REALTOR® or Affiliate member of the Laredo Association of REALTORS® in good standing.
- B. Eligible students must be either
  - a) a high school graduate of the class of 2020 that is attending an accredited university or college in the Fall of 2020 and will continue in the Spring of 2021.
  - or
  - b) a student currently enrolled as a full time undergraduate student in an accredited university or college and plans to continue attending as an undergraduate in the Spring of 2021.
- C. Students must be in a good academic standing.
- D. A current high school or college transcript must be provided.
- E. A scholarship application must be filled out by eligible participants correctly and neatly along with an essay.
- F. Only complete applications received with essay by deadline will be considered.
- G. Student must be a US Resident.
- H. To give opportunities to all members we are limiting application to only students that have not previously won a scholarship.
- I. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, color, sex, religion, national origin, familial status, handicap, sexual orientation or gender identity.
